You'll learn how to analyse and translate texts in Old and Middle English (spoken in the Middle Ages). You will look at how sentences, words and sounds are structured and the development that the language has undergone. In addition to acquiring an excellent command of the English language, you'll become acquainted with the literature, culture and history of the Englishspeaking world, from the early Middle Ages to the present day, and learn how to communicate effectively in English. In short, the following rules apply:



- Tuition fees
- The "EU/EEA rate" is the regular fee for students from within the EU/EEA.

 - The "institutional rate" is for all students who have already obtained a bachelor's or master's degree and who want to start a second programme leading to a degree at the same level or at a lower level.
 - Note that FT, PT and D stand for "full-time", "part-time" and "dual", respectively.
